- Whereas Seongdong-Gu, Seoul, Republic of Korea and Cobb County, State of Georgia, United States of America entered into a Sister City Relationship in October 2007, and
- Whereas the relationship has provided opportunities for economic, educational, and cultural growth and development, and
- Whereas this Sister City relationship has strengthened ties and fostered good working relationships between our citizens, and
- Whereas both parties wish to continue this Sister City relationship and support and encourage additional opportunities for the exchange of people, ideas, and information in a variety of economic, social, cultural, professional, education and youth developments, now
- Therefore Cobb County and Seongdong-Gu do hereby declare their intent to continue their Sister City relationship and to abide by the guidelines according to Sister Cities International policies.
