Pickett's Mill Elementary School School Zone Safety & Operational Improvements

The Pickett's Mill Elementary School/Old Stilesboro Road Project (E8100) will improve safety by enhancing motorist's ability to enter and exit the school. Improvements at the main school driveway on Old Stilesboro Road will reduce traffic congestion during peak school hours. The project consists of widening the main school entrance creating two entering and two exiting one-way lanes, lengthening the roadway right-turn lane, and additional enhancements to increase queuing for vehicles accessing the school. This is a joint school zone safety and operational improvement project funded by both Cobb County DOT and Cobb County School District.

Did You Know?

- About 730 students attend Pickett's Mill Elementary School
- Approximately 43 percent of students are driven to school on a typical day
- This project will also improve safety and traffic flow for school and commuter drivers.
- This project will help keep kids safe!

Project Quick Facts

- Construction start date is May 2016
- Expected completion is before school resumes on Monday, Aug. 1, 2016
- The roadway portion of this project is funded by the Cobb County 2011 SPLOST Transportation component. Cobb County School District, with SPLOST 4, is funding costs for driveway and associated improvements on school property (off County right-of-way)
- Project details are on reverse side
