The park is owned by the City and the Splash Pad is being developed in a joint effort between the City and the County. The project consists of the design and construction of a new Splash Pad located near the existing restroom building. Project responsibility includes all design, permitting and construction required to complete the work pursuant to the project plans, specifications and addenda.

Bidder is responsible for printing and reviewing all bid documents prior to submitting a bid. Partial sets of documents will not be issued

Proposals must be accompanied by Bid Security in the amount not less than five percent (5%) of the Base Bid. Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond, each in the amount equal to 100% of the contract sum, will be required of the successful bidder. Bonds must be written by a surety company licensed to do business in the State of Georgia, have a "Best's" rating of "A" or better, appear on the current U.S. Treasury Department List of Sureties that are acceptable on bonds for the Federal Government (Circular 570), and have recommended bond limits equal to or in excess of those required for this Project; or otherwise acceptable to the Owner.

In order to insure compliance with OCGA 13-10-91, the proposal must be accompanied by the appropriate executed copy(s) of Contractor Affidavit & Agreements. Refer to the Project Manual for additional information.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of ninety (90) days after date of bid opening, unless otherwise specified. The competency and responsibility of proposers will be considered by the Owner in making the award. The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to waive any informalities, to reject portions of the proposal, to waive technicalities and to award contracts in a manner consistent with the interest of the Owner and the laws of the State of Georgia.
