The Cobb County CDBG Program Office is accepting Phase 33 applications for the Emergency Food and Shelter National Board Program (EFSP) funded through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) under the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act.

Approximately \$305,000.00 is expected to be provided by a federal appropriation from Congress to the Emergency Food and Shelter Program. Applications are available to local organizations for funding to provide emergency food and shelter for homeless and persons at-risk of becoming homeless in Cobb County. Applicants must be public or non-profit community service organizations and meet the appropriate financial and operating standards. Applicants must also be able to report monthly expenditures for reimbursement and provide an independent annual audit. Applications are available at www.cobbcounty.org/cdbg. Applications are due to the CDBG Program Office on or before 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 30, 2015. LATE PROPOSALS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
