FFY2017 COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT**

The Cobb County CDBG Program Office will be accepting applications for the Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) program for FFY2017, funded through the Georgia Department of Human Services (DHS). Non-profit organizations and public agencies that serve or will serve Cobb County residents at or below 125% of the federal poverty level are encouraged to apply. All services provided with CSBG funds must be intended to help move clients out of poverty.

An application workshop will be held at 10:30 a.m. on Wednesday, June 8, 2016 at the Charles D. Switzer Public Library located at 266 Roswell Street, Marietta, GA. All applicants are encouraged to attend.

The application period is **June 1, 2016 – June 30, 2016**. Applications must be physically received at the CDBG Program Office, 192 Anderson Street, Suite 150, Marietta, GA 30060 no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 30, 2016. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered for funding.
