A Public Review Meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on **Wednesday, May 6, 2015** at the Cobb County CDBG Program Office Conference Room located at 121 Haynes Street Marietta, Georgia 30060 to receive comments on the final projects for the City of Marietta and the City of Smyrna's PY2015 final CDBG allocations and the reallocation of CDBG funds from the City of Marietta's Blackwell Park to the YWCA of Northwest GA for facility improvements. The City of Marietta will allocate \$105,500 for Administration and Planning, \$265,778 for Housing Rehabilitation, \$5,000 for the Marietta Mentoring Program, \$58,000 for Marietta YELLS, \$16,000 for the Police Athletic League, and \$7,296 for SafePath Children's Advocacy Center. The City of Marietta will also reallocate prior year funds currently allocated for Blackwell Park to the YWCA of Northwest GA for facility improvements. The City of Smyrna will allocate \$35,000 for Administration and Planning, \$50,000 for Code Enforcement, \$105,000 for Rose Garden Park Restroom Replacement, \$44,500 for improvements at Church Street.

This amendment is classified as substantial and warrants a Public Review Meeting and comment period. A 30-day Public Comment period begins Friday, April 24, 2015 and ends at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, May 25, 2015.
