Safety & Operational Improvements

The project will provide safety and operational improvements to Lower Roswell Road between SR 120/South Marietta Parkway and Holt Road. Key components are summarized below:

- Extending the second eastbound through lane between SR 120/South Marietta Parkway and Clearwater Drive
- Providing a center turn lane from Indian Trail to Old Sewell Road
- Adding a right turn lane and lengthening the left turn lane for Sedalia Park Elementary School
- Creating a right turn lane at the entrance to Eastvalley Elementary School
- Constructing a right turn lane on Lower Roswell Road at Holt Road
- Upgrading traffic signals at both Old Sewell Road and Holt Road
- Filling in sidewalk gaps along both sides of Lower Roswell Road from SR 120/South Marietta Parkway to Holt Road
- Resurfacing the entire road from SR 120/South Marietta Parkway to Terrell Mill Road

Project Quick Facts

- Start of construction: Fall 2016
- Expected completion: Winter 2018
- Project length: 1.29 miles (not including resurfacing to Terrell Mill Road)
- This portion of Lower Roswell Road was selected due to safety and operational concerns voiced by a number of citizens along the corridor as well as observations and studies conducted by Cobb DOT.
- This project is funded through the 2005 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) Program.
- Access to driveways and mail service will be maintained at all times.
