

Description of Cumberland Circulator Effective March 2017

Core Cumberland Circulator Route

Proposed clockwise route to operate in a continuous loop from the Cumberland Transit Center via Cumberland Boulevard, Riverwood Parkway, Cobb Parkway, Akers Mill Road, Galleria Drive, Professional Parkway, Cobb Parkway (to be potentially replaced by a future pedestrian/transit bridge across I-285), Circle 75 Parkway, Heritage Court, Windy Ridge Parkway, Interstate North Parkway (to Marriott and back, continuing south), Cumberland Boulevard, Akers Mill Road and Cumberland Boulevard, turning around at Cumberland Mall to return to the Cumberland Transit Center.

Counterclockwise route is proposed to operate in the reverse direction of the proposed clockwise route.

Proposed Core Route Service Span and Frequency each direction:

- Weekdays 6-9 AM – 30 minutes
- Weekdays 9 AM-4 PM – 15 minutes
- Weekdays 4-7 PM – 30 minutes
- Weekdays 7-11 PM – 30 minutes
- Saturdays 9:30 AM-9:30 PM – 30 minutes
- Sundays 9:30 AM-9:30 PM – 30 minutes (Sunday service is contingent upon implementation of CobbLinc Sunday service.)

South Cumberland Circulator Route

Proposed southbound route to operate from the Cumberland Transit Center via Cumberland Mall to return to southbound Cumberland Parkway, Paces Ferry Road, Spring Hill Parkway and into The Home Depot campus. Northbound service operates via Skyline Trail, Paces Ferry Road, Cumberland Parkway and Cumberland Boulevard to the Cumberland Transit Center.

Proposed South Route Service Span and Frequency each direction:

- Weekdays 9 AM-4 PM – 30 minutes

Implementation of complementary ADA service for the above new routes to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

A court reporter will be available during this time to allow the public an opportunity to make comments about the proposed modification. These comments will be included in the transcript of the Public Hearing. **Oral and written comments will be accepted through Oct. 27, 2016** by phone, e-mail or fax.
