On April 7, 2014, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Cobb Chamber of Commerce, Community Room, 240 Interstate North Parkway, Atlanta, Georgia 30339, the Cobb County Department of Transportation will hold a public information OPEN HOUSE for the **I-75 at Windy Hill Road interchange improvements project**.

These improvements are a component of the 2011 1% Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) program.

The proposed project consists of converting the existing interchange to a diverging diamond interchange (DDI) utilizing the existing bridge while providing operational improvements. Most of the project will be contained within the existing paved area.

The proposed project would consist of the reconfiguration of the interchange at Windy Hill Road to a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI). The reconfiguration would involve removal of the Windy Hill Road westbound to southbound loop on-ramp and the separation of the southbound on-ramp and providing the left-turn traffic movement at a new intersection of the DDI. Additionally, the intersections of Windy Hill at Circle 75 Parkway and Leland Drive would be relocated and moved away from the DDI crossover intersections. The I-75 southbound through and right-turn movements would be aligned across from the relocated Circle 75 Parkway. Interstate North Parkway (West) would be cul-de-saced and the relocated Leland Drive would be aligned across from a commercial driveway leading to two restaurants. The Windy Hill Road Bridge over I-75 would not be widened but reconfigured to have six lanes (three in each direction) and a median fourteen feet wide. Pedestrian traffic would be facilitated along the center median of the bridge. Sidewalks are provided on both sides of Windy Hill Road outside the DDI intersections.

The purpose of this Open House is to provide the public with an opportunity to view the proposed project, ask questions, and to express their interest and concerns about the proposal.

The Open House will be conducted between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. The public is invited to attend anytime during these hours to review the proposed plans for this project. **There will be no formal presentation.** A court reporter will be available during this time to allow the public the opportunity to make comments about the project.

Written statements will be accepted concerning this project until April 18, 2014. All comments will be presented to the Cobb County Board of Commissioners for their consideration regarding this project.
