



# Cobb County Department of Transportation New Chastain Road Westbound Bridge Replacement


This summer, Cobb DOT will replace the **westbound bridge** on New Chastain Road over Noonday Creek. Beginning in late May, project construction will last approximately four to six months.

Built in 1972, and widened in 1993, the existing bridge is structurally deficient according to GDOT bridge inspection reports.

Four lanes will be reduced to two lanes during construction, resulting in westbound traffic being shifted to the eastbound bridge, with one lane in each direction throughout the duration of the project. Average daily traffic for New Chastain Road is 21,500; expect delays during construction.

An alternate route is suggested by using Bells Ferry, Canton, and Piedmont Roads. See map.
