The schedule may change dependent upon departmental activities and events. Evenings and Weekend work will be required for these positions.

<b>Essential Duties</b>	<p>Performs general facility maintenance and custodial duties.</p> <p>Performs exterior maintenance to include but not limited to: mowing of grass, picking up trash and loose paper, the dragging and lining of athletic fields, weed eating, cleaning of restrooms, etc.</p> <p>Performs special event set-ups and take-downs of chairs, tables, stages, tents, etc.</p> <p>Assists with the day to day maintenance operations for various parks and locations.</p> <p>Weekend event coverage at parks and facilities to include but not be limited to: athletic complexes (dragging/lining of fields prior to event start, raking/lining of fields during the event, cleaning restrooms as needed, etc) festivals and shows (setting up for the event, cleaning/stocking restrooms, picking up loose trash, emptying trash cans, etc.) and maintenance for other special events.</p> <p>Uses hand tools such as: shovels, picks, rakes, etc. in performing grounds keeping and landscaping activities.</p> <p>Operates power tools and machinery used in landscaping such as: push mowers, weed eaters, edgers, zero turn radius mowers, etc.</p> <p>Assists others in performing minor facility repairs requiring some basic skills in carpentry, painting, plumbing and irrigation.</p> <p>Performs other work related duties as assigned.</p>
